Re: Your Complaint to Elections Ontario against Vaughan Working Families - File
reference: 2020-11

The Chief Electoral Officer has reviewed all the evidence in relation to this matter and decided that there has been an apparent contravention of section 37.5 and section 48 of the *Election Finances Act* by Vaughan Health Campus of Care, a company operating business as Vaughan Working Families, by its failure to register with Elections Ontario as a third party.

The Chief Electoral Officer has therefore reported this matter to the Ministry of the Attorney General.

In accordance with the protocol I have attached for your reference, once the Chief Electoral Officer reports an apparent contravention it may be investigated by a police service and, with the consent of the Chief Electoral Officer, prosecuted by the Crown.

Upon conviction, the penalty for a violation of section 37.5 and section 48 of the Act is a fine of not more than \$5,000.
